




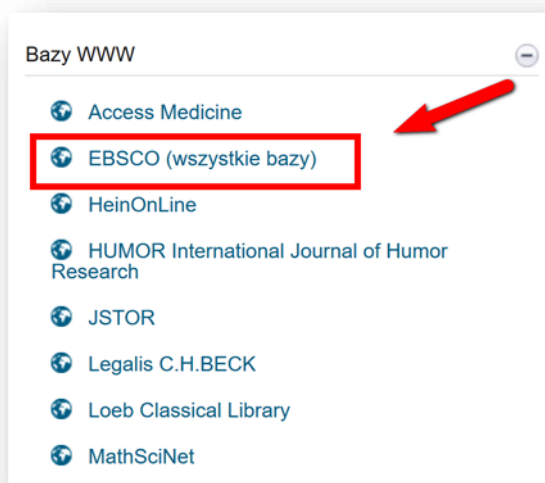
# REMOTE ACCESS TO THE UKSW LIBRARIES ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

1. **Enter the page <https://pulpit.uksw.edu.pl>** and log in by UKSW Central Authentication Service (username and password are the same as to the USOSWeb UKSW).



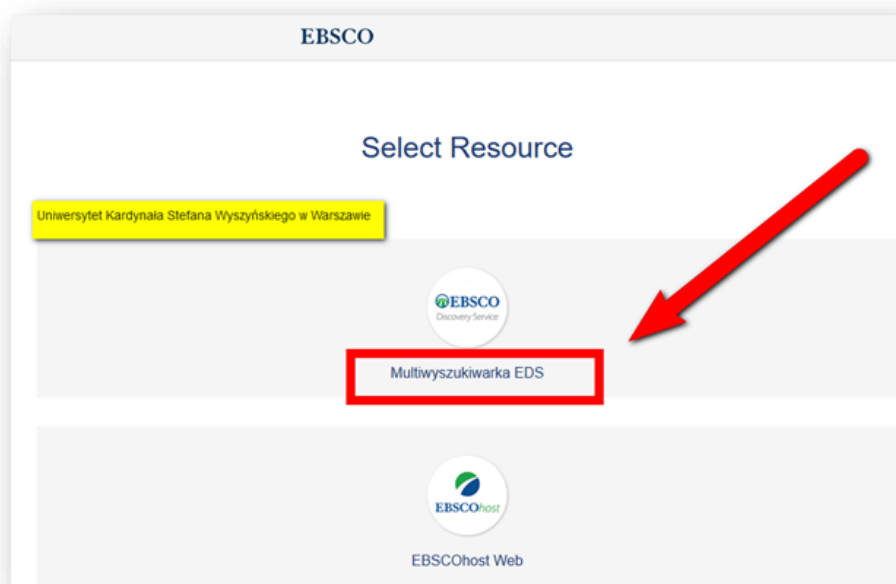

2. A list of remote access databases will appear. You can browse separately each of databases or use EDS Multi-search (it can search through most of databases which are subscribed by the library and within some of generally available databases). To enter EDS Multi-search choose the **EBSCO (wszystkie bazy)** link.

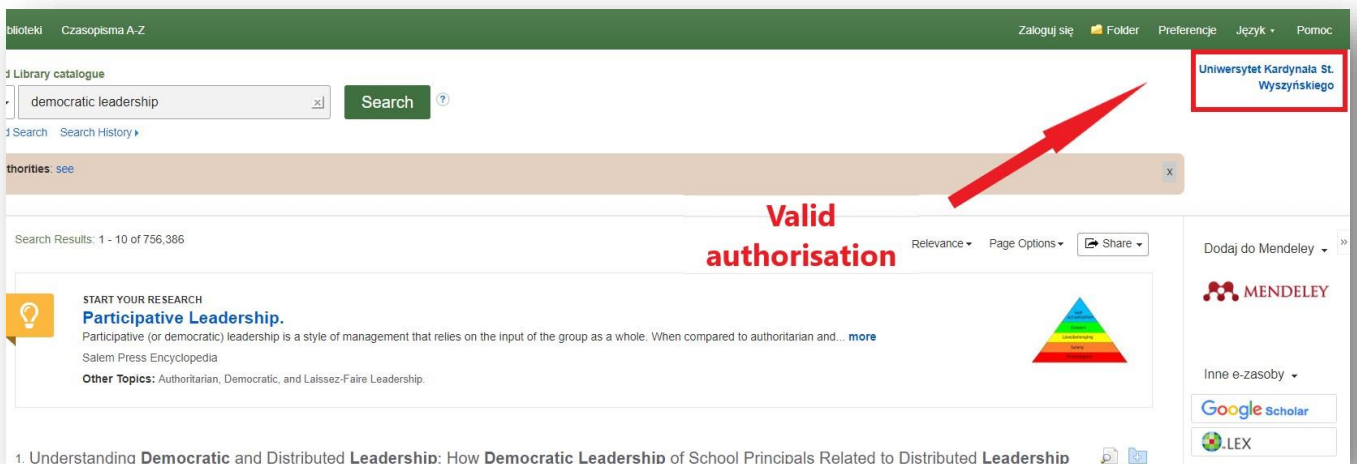
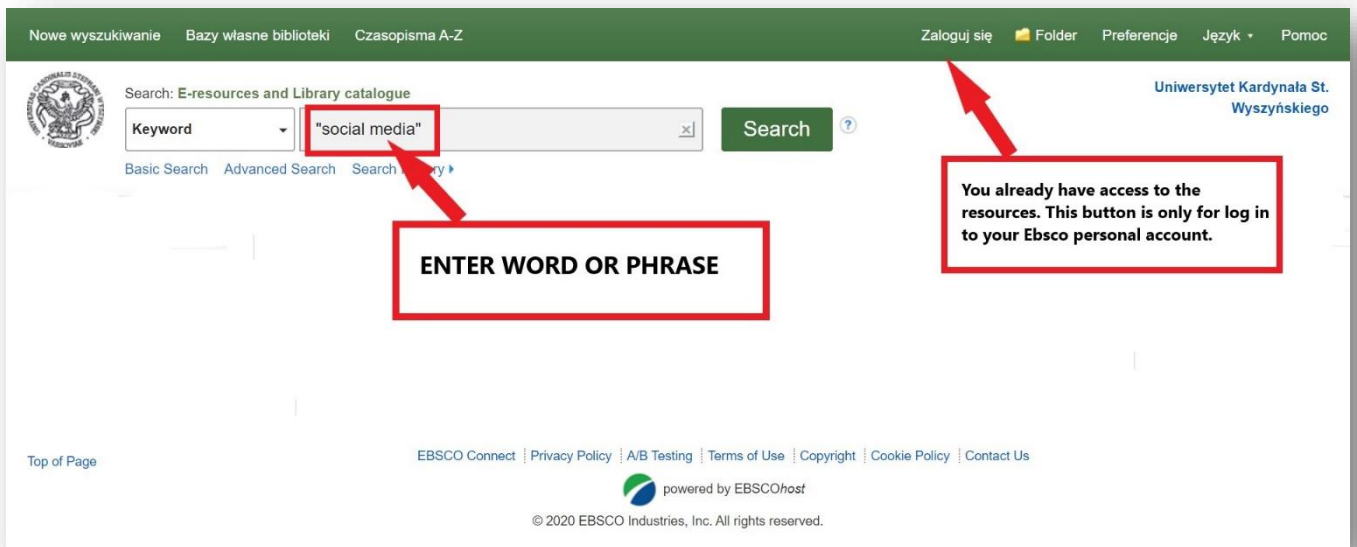


Please, notice that EDS Multi-search cannot search through the databases of some individual providers, i.e. Wolters Kluwer LEX, C.H. Beck Legalis, The Thesaurus Linguae Graecae etc.

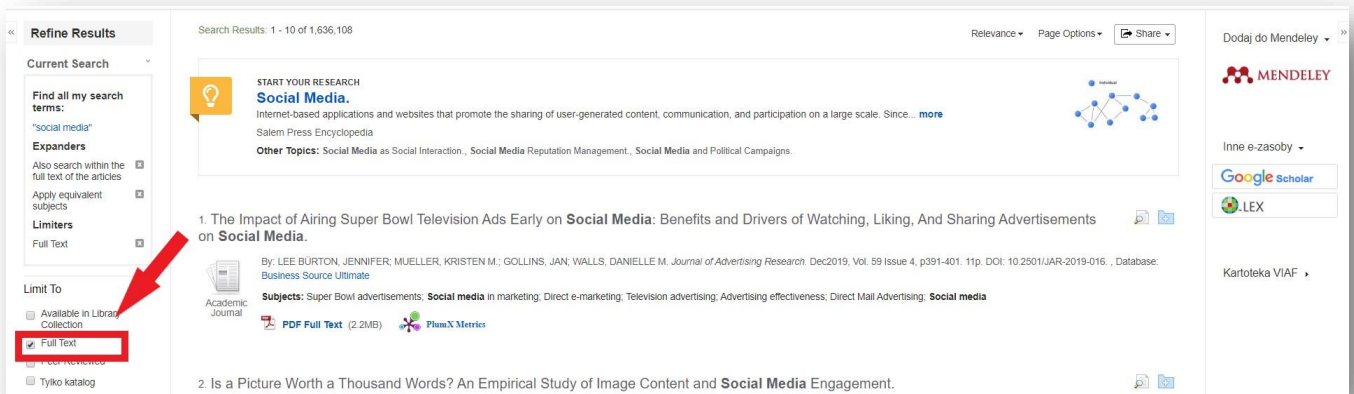
3. Next select resource **Multiwyszukiwarka EDS (EDS Multi-search)**.



4. In the Multi-search window **enter any words or „search phrase”** (depending on the search language the results can be different).



5. To narrow the search results to „Full Text” please choose this option in the search filters section (refine results section on the left)

**Full text is usually provided in PDF or HTML file format.** Please, notice that for HTML text versions there is automatic screen reader and translator available.
