



How to activate remote access to Elsevier databases (Scopus/ScienceDirect)?

Login details of remote access to the Elsevier databases will be sent on the e-mail given in a **contact form [dać link]**.

In order to activate remote access to Elsevier you must:

1. Go to: <https://www.scopus.com/register> or <https://www.sciencedirect.com/science/register>. Next steps are the same for both of databases.
2. Type in „**Registration ID**” (into „**Registration ID**” field) and „**Registration Password**” (into „**Passcode**” field). Their localization have been marked by the red frame on screenshots below:
