

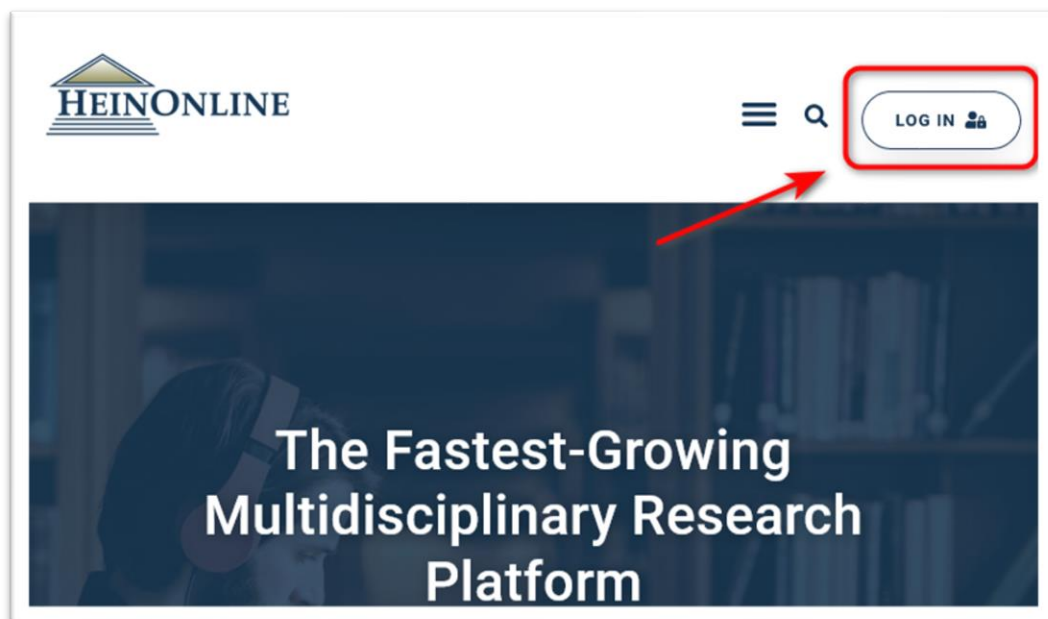

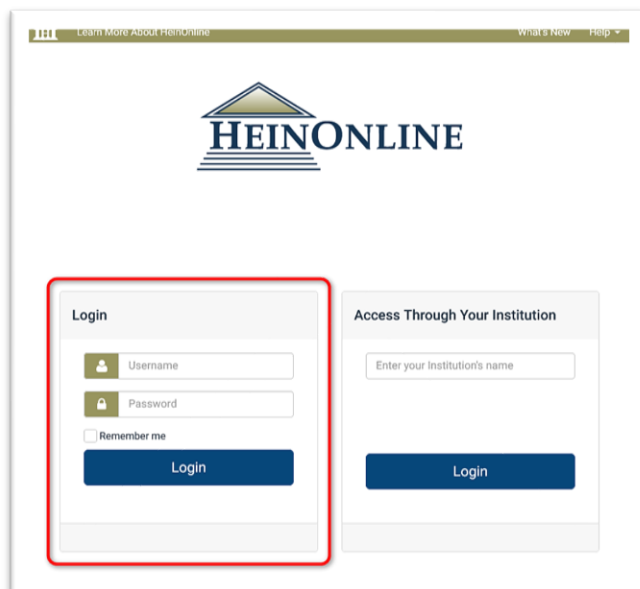
Access to the HeinOnline database both remotely and from the UKSW network **is made through the publisher's webpage** (bypassing the UKSW Pulpit service).

In order to use HeinOnline database:

1. Go to <https://home.heinonline.org>.
2. Click **LOG IN** in right upper corner.



3. Enter the login details received via the contact form; **username** and **password**, then click **Login** or **Enter** button.





4. Once you have logged in correctly, you will see a view that includes all the thematic categories on the HeinOnline platform.
