

Access to electronic databases

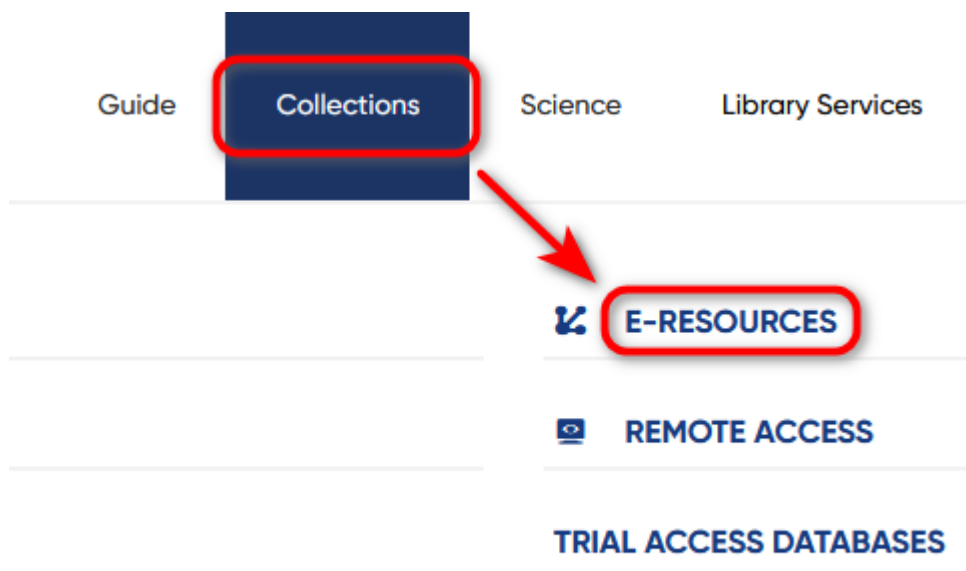
From March 2024 access to electronic databases subscribed by UKSW is carried out using the **Hidden Automation Navigator (HAN) system**. HAN is an automatic authentication system, working on a proxy basis, using the Microsoft365 UKSW login.

There is currently a transitional period in which remote access, as well as from the UKSW network, requires login via Microsoft365 UKSW. After the transition period, access from the University network will not require a login.

The current remote access platform, Pulpit UKSW, will be deactivated.

In order to use e-resources in this way, you need to:

1. Go to biblioteka.uksw.edu.pl/en/, choose **Collections**, and then **E-RESOURCES** tab.





2. Choose a database and click on its name.

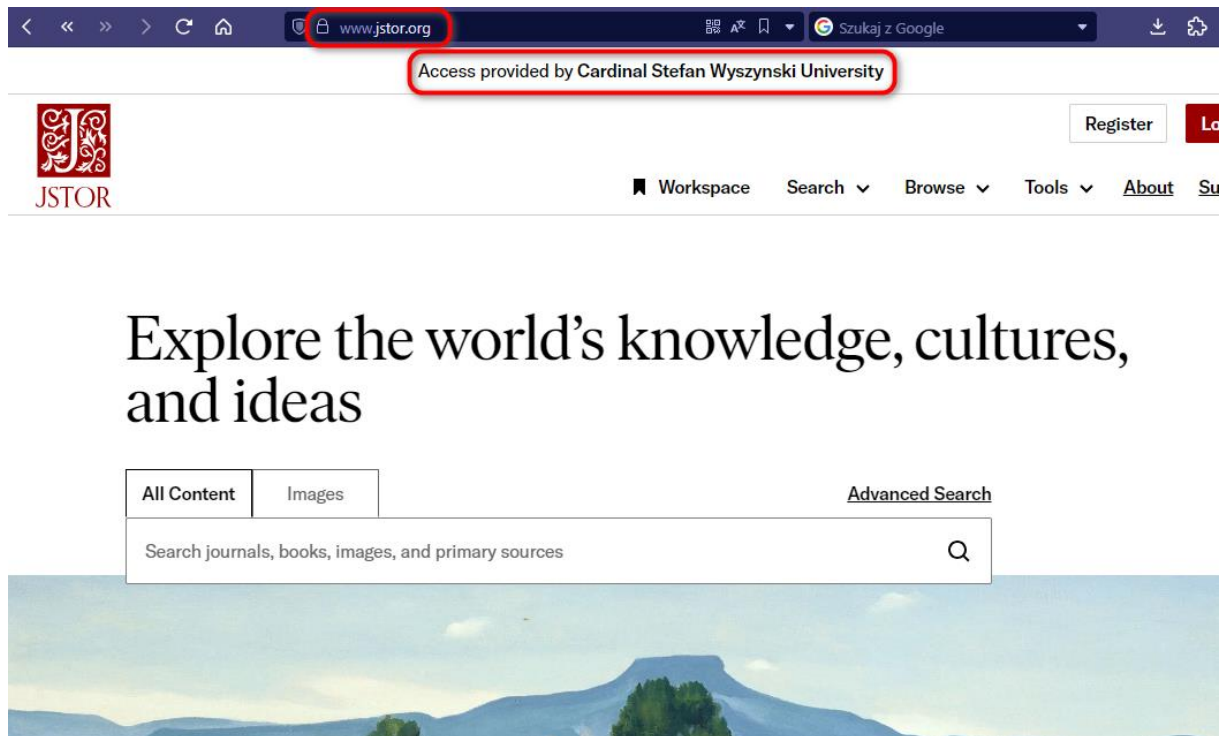
In the new login window, enter your access data **including the domain** according to example: **identifier@domain** – „**identifier@uksw.edu.pl**”.

ID examples:

Group of Users	ID format	Example
Employees	n.surname/name.surname	j.doe / john.doe
Students	##### (album, index number)	111111
Doctoral Students	D- #####	D-1111
Postgraduate Students	P- #####	P-11111

3. After correct authorization, the name of the University will be displayed, in most cases, in the upper part of the database page.



Not all databases show the name of the University after logging in.

The way of use of the **Legalis C.H. Beck** database is unchanged.

Logging in to the **HeinOnline** database takes place according to separate rules described on the page <https://biblioteka.uksw.edu.pl/en/collections/e-resources/>

To use the resources of the **Thesaurus Linguae Graecae** database, an individual account must be created.
