

Access to electronic databases


Access to the electronic databases subscribed by UKSW is carried out using the **Hidden Automation Navigator (HAN) system**, using the Microsoft365 UKSW login.

There is currently a transitional period in which remote access, as well as from the UKSW network, requires login via Microsoft365 UKSW. After the transition period, access from the University network will not require a login.

The current remote access platform, Pulpit UKSW, will be deactivated.

In order to use e-resources in this way, you need to:

 Go to <u>biblioteka.uksw.edu.pl/en/</u>, choose Collections, and then E-RESOURCES tab.

In the new login window, enter your access data **including the domain** according to an example: identifier@domain – "identifier@uksw.edu.pl".








3. In the next step, enter the **One-time code** generated in the authentication application on your phone and confirm with the **Submit** button.
